## ASAP (Additional Skill Acquisition Programme) ASAP 2016-2017

ASAP is an initiative implemented by Govt. of Kerala in 2012. This program aims at imparting skills in students to excel in personal and professional spheres. Our college provides a nice environment for the smooth functioning of ASAP.

ASAP aims at developing skill programmes in three levels. At present level 1 programme is being implemented, under which three courses, namely, two foundation courses (Communication Skills in English and Basic IT) and one elective skill course are conducted. Students can select the skill course based on her/his aptitude from the bouquet of skill courses being offered by ASAP. To ensure labour market acceptance and employability, skill courses are developed and delivered with the active participation of related industries and also in consultation with the National Occupational Standards being notified by various Sector Skill Councils under National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). Proper care is also given for future integration of the courses with National Vocational Education Qualifications Framework (NVEQF).

Currently ASAP is having Dr. Vipin P Sivaram as its coordinator, having taken over the charge from Dr. Gopakumar G. Foundation course is conducted by Mrs. Sneha Vijay. Apart from the regular hours of study, students get involved in various activities in the college campus on special occasions. ASAP has formed a club "VIBGYOR" and its activities include publications in bulletin, organising quiz programmes and green campus campaign.
